



<p><b>Eight Parts of Speech</b></p> <p>Secondary  <b>Duration:</b> 14 Minutes</p>	<p>Students understand that learning the eight parts of speech helps people to know the function of words, and how they are joined together to make coherent sentences. They will be introduced to the noun, pronoun, verb, adjective, adverb, preposition, conjunction and interjection. They will also realise that depending on its use the same word can represent a different part of speech.</p>
